Our students are immersed in media and technology rich environments outside of the classroom. Let's make the classroom just as connected and engaging.

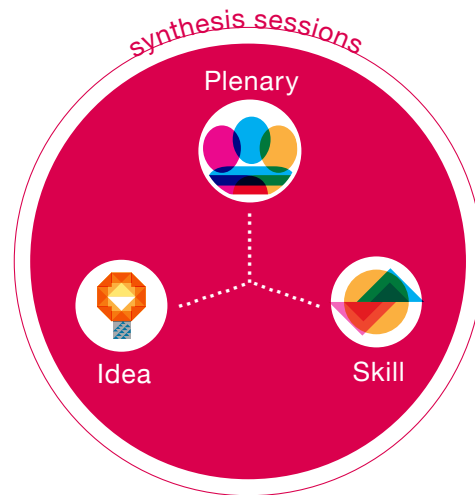
### THE CONNECTED SCHOOL
