The conference will feature

- **Synthesis sessions** scheduled at the end of each day to help the participants reflect on the day’s activities, share personal insights and network with other participants, and allow them to contextualize what they learn given their own school’s needs and resources

This conference is open to education majors, teachers, school administrators and decision makers, and even parents. It is for those who are not familiar with technology-enhanced teaching and learning. It is also for those who are deciding whether or not to pursue a technology-infused classroom. It is still also for those already doing integrating technology and exploring One2One learning.
